



ISLANDS OF HISTORY

The 25th Anniversary Conference of the Professional Historians Association (NSW) Inc will be held at Norfolk Island, from 18 – 25 July 2010, to coincide with the UNESCO decision on including Kingston and Arthur's Vale Historic Area in the World Heritage List.

SECOND CALL FOR PAPERS

Papers related to one of these themes are invited from all historians:

- Writing convict history
- South Pacific maritime history
- Christian missionaries in the South Seas
- Pre-history of Pacific islands
- Heritage and history
- Migration and settlement

There are many historic islands in the South Pacific. Already we have received abstracts for papers about New Zealand, Tahiti, Pitcairn, and Cockatoo Island in Sydney Harbour, in addition to Norfolk Island. We would like additional coverage of these themes and places, so have extended the closing date for submissions until **28 February**.

Presenters will be allotted 20 minutes to read their papers at the conference, with an additional 10 minutes for questions and discussion. Please send a 150-200 word abstract and a short biographical note to: secretary@phansw.org.au

Alternatively, there will be scope for 'poster presentations', where panels up to 1 metre square will be displayed during the conference, illustrating and describing the author's current research projects. During refreshment breaks delegates will be invited to discuss posters with the authors.
